CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries must be presented in a, complete and safe working order. Please display entry pass at all time.
2. All entries must be insured for third party risk, and road vehicles must be fully licensed (where applicable) and tested or exempt in accordance with the construction and use regulations for the class of vehicle. Please have your original insurance certificate with you, an official may ask to inspect it, failure to comply, will imply that the vehicle is not insured, in which case it will only be allowed on site as a static display.
3. Owners must ensure that all drivers are fully competent and permitted by law (licensed & insured) to operate the vehicle.
4. No exhibit may be left running unattended; all unattended exhibits must be securely braked or chocked.
5. A maximum speed limit of 5mph will apply to all movements on the rally site, please take care and be aware of children and pedestrians at all times. Armoured vehicle movements should have a walking marshal preceding the vehicle to clear the way.
6. Exhibitors must pay full regard to rally officials/marshals instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience or endanger any persons at any time.
7. No additional vehicle may be brought onto the site without prior permission; free vehicle parking is available in the camping area.
8. Details of acceptance and vehicle passes will be sent in due course, these permit 2 adults and 2 children, additional persons must pay the normal gate admission fee.
9. Exhibitors will not move any vehicles on the show field, during public opening hours, without the prior permission of the show organisers or their officials.
10. For safety reasons gas operated barbecues only, will be permitted on the rally and camping fields (NOT THE CAR PARK)
11. CAMPING AND CARAVANS: - These units are to be sited on the field as instructed by the show organisers, in accordance with the caravan club guidelines, (3 meters from the adjoining awning if used). GENERATORS NOT PERMITTED TO RUN AFTER 10PM
12. DRIVERS: - Unlicensed drivers will not be permitted to drive any vehicle however powered on the rally, camping or parking fields. The same laws apply on the show field as on the public highway.
13. PASSENGERS: - Passengers will not ride on any vehicle (except on properly constructed seats) on any fields occupied by the show.
14. FUEL: - Fuel will not be transferred on the camping site on any permeable surface.
15. All vehicles must be equipped with working, modern fire extinguishers.
16. The use of any pyrotechnics, except where permitted in a display, is prohibited. *Anyone failing to observe this rule will be asked to leave the site immediately*
17. LITTER: - Exhibitors are expected to maintain their area and the ground adjacent to it in a clean and tidy condition, all rubbish should be placed in the bin bags and litter bins or skips on site.
